- 1 insurance or a managed care plan that is amended, delivered, issued, or renewed on or after January 1, 2026 shall provide 2 coverage for medically necessary hormonal and non-hormonal 3 4 therapy to treat menopausal symptoms if the therapy is 5 recommended by a qualified health care provider who is licensed, accredited, or certified under Illinois law and the 6 therapy has been proven safe and effective in peer-reviewed 7 scientific studies. Coverage for therapy to treat menopausal 8 9 symptoms shall include all federal Food and Drug 10 Administration-approved modalities of hormonal and non-hormonal administration, including, but not limited to, 11
- Section 10. The Illinois Public Aid Code is amended by changing Section 5-16.8 and by adding Section 5-52 as follows:
