The Code of Civil Procedure is amended by 4 5 adding Section 21-106 as follows: 6 (735 ILCS 5/21-106 new) 7 Sec. 21-106. Judicial order; findings of fact. (a) Legislative intent. Residents of this State who were 8 born in another state or in another country may have 9 10 difficulty in securing a birth certificate with the correct information. It is the intent of the General Assembly that 11 12 Illinois should have a legal process available for these residents to seek a judicial order making findings of fact so 13 that they may petition the issuing jurisdiction to change a 14 15 birth certificate.
