2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The State Commemorative Dates Act is amended by
5 adding Section 61 as follows:

6 (5 ILCS 490/61 new)

7 Sec. 61. John Lewis Day. The twenty-first day of February
8 of each year shall be known as John Lewis Day, to be observed
9 throughout the State as a day to remember the accomplishments
10 of the civil rights icon and to honor his legacy and dedication
11 to public service.
