SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Makes appropriations for the ordinary and contingent expenses of the Department of Human Rights for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2024, as follows:

General Funds	\$17,958,800
Other State Funds	\$ 5,600,000
Federal Funds	\$ 4,794,800
Total	<u>\$28,353,600</u>

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A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. The sum of \$16,063,800, or so much thereof as
6 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund
7 to the Department of Human Rights for operational expenses of
8 the Department.

9 Section 10. The sum of \$270,000, or so much thereof as may
10 be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to
11 the Department of Human Rights for costs associated with
12 employer and employee training programs.

13 Section 15. The sum of \$625,000, or so much thereof as may
14 be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to
15 the Department of Human Rights for costs associated with the
16 Commission on Discrimination and Hate Crimes.

17 Section 20. The sum of \$100,000, or so much thereof as may
18 be necessary, is appropriated from the Department of Human
19 Rights Training and Development Fund to the Department of Human

1 Rights for the purpose of funding expenses associated with
2 administration.

3 Section 25. The sum of \$4,794,800, or so much thereof as
4 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Special Projects
5 Division Fund to the Department of Human Rights for operational
6 expenses of the Department.

7 Section 30. The sum of \$500,000, or so much thereof as may
8 be necessary, is appropriated from the Department of Human
9 Rights Special Fund to the Department of Human Rights for the
10 purpose of filing expenses associated with the Department of
11 Human Rights.

12 Section 35. The sum of \$5,000,000, or so much thereof as
13 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Hate Crimes and Bias
14 Incident Prevention and Response Fund to the Department of
15 Human Rights for grants and administrative expenses associated
16 with the eradication of hate crimes and bias incidents.

17 Section 40. The sum of \$1,000,000, or so much thereof as
18 may be necessary, and remains unexpended at the close of
19 business on June 30, 2024, from an appropriation made for such
20 purpose in Article 55, Section 35 of Public Act 103-006, as
21 amended, is reappropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the

1 Department of Human Rights for the purpose of providing a grant
2 to the Simon Wiesenthal Center's Midwest Region Office in
3 Chicago to operate a mobile museum bus for tolerance.

4 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
5 2024.
