2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 1. The following named amounts, or so much thereof
6 as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects and purposes
7 hereinafter named, are appropriated to the Capital Development

20 Section 5. The sum of \$500,000, or so much thereof as may
21 be necessary, is appropriated from the Energy Transition
22 Assistance Fund to the Capital Development Board for
23 operational expenses and administration of the Energy
24 Transition Act, including the creation and adoption of the

1 Illinois Stretch Energy Code.

2 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
3 2024.
