9 Section 10. The sum of \$750,000, or so much thereof as may 10 be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois Underground 11 Utility Facilities Damage Prevention Fund to the Illinois 12 Commerce Commission for a grant to the Statewide One-call 13 Notice System, as required in the Illinois Underground Utility 14 Facilities Damage Prevention Act.

15 Section 15. The sum of \$1,000, or so much thereof as may 16 be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois Underground 17 Utility Facilities Damage Prevention Fund to the Illinois 18 Commerce Commission for refunds.

19 Section 20. The following named amounts, or so much thereof 20 as may be necessary, respectively, are appropriated from the 21 Transportation Regulatory Fund for ordinary and contingent 22 expenses to the Illinois Commerce Commission:

17 Section 25. The sum of \$2,000,000, or so much thereof as 18 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Transportation 19 Regulatory Fund to the Illinois Commerce Commission for (1) 20 disbursing funds collected for the Single State Insurance 21 Registration Program and/or Unified Carrier Registration 22 System; (2) for refunds for overpayments; and (3) for 23 administrative expenses. -5- OMB103 00321 AAV 45321 b

1 Section 30. The sum of \$1,500,000, or so much thereof as 2 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois Telecommunications Access Corporation Fund to the Illinois 3 administrative 4 Commerce Commission for costs and for 5 distribution to the Illinois Telecommunications Access 6 Corporation, as required in the Illinois Public Utilities Act, 7 Section 13-703.

8 Section 35. The sum of \$12,000,000, or so much thereof as 9 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Public Utility Fund 10 to the Illinois Commerce Commission for all costs associated 11 with the administration of the Energy Transition Act.

Section 40. The sum of \$3,000,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Consumer Intervenor Compensation Fund to the Illinois Commerce Commission for all costs and expenses associated with the administration of the Consumer Intervenor Compensation Fund, and amendments to Section 9-229 of the Illinois Public Utilities Act resulting from enactment of Illinois Public Act 102-0662.

Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
20 2024.
