A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented**
3 **in the General Assembly:**

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. The sum of \$13,051,800, or so much thereof as
6 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Dram Shop Fund to
7 the Liquor Control Commission for operational expenses.

8 Section 10. The following named sums, or so much thereof
9 as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects and purposes
10 hereinafter named, are appropriated to the Liquor Control
11 Commission:

PAYABLE FROM DRAM SHOP FUND	
13	For Refunds5,000
14	For expenses related to the
