## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

Makes appropriations for the ordinary and contingent expenses of the Illinois State Board of Education and teacher retirement contributions for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2024, as follows:

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

4 ARTICLE 1
