2 WHEREAS, This year will mark the 35th anniversary of the 3 establishment and recognition of National Black Nurses Day by 4 the 101st United States Congress; and

5 WHEREAS, Black people have long been active in the nursing 6 field in the U.S.; currently, they comprise 6.7% of the total 7 nursing population and practice in a variety of areas, 8 including clinical, education, administrative, research, 9 government, and private enterprise; and

10 WHEREAS, Black nurses have made significant contributions 11 to the nursing profession; as attention to the health care 12 problems of minorities and the poor increases, Black nurses 13 can be credited for establishing an environment of quality, 14 service, and skill that patients have come to expect from 15 health care practitioners; and

16 WHEREAS, Since February honors the contributions made to 17 this country by Black Americans, it is fitting that Black 18 nurses be recognized and honored for their outstanding 19 contributions to our communities and our country; therefore, 20 be it
