1 HOUSE RESOLUTION 2 WHEREAS, The ability to read is fundamental to 3 individual's success and their ability to take part in our 4 democracy as a responsible citizen; and 5 WHEREAS, According to 2022 data from the National 6 Assessment of Education Progress (NAEP), one third of Illinois 7 children are reading below their basic grade level; and 8 WHEREAS, A study by the Annie E. Casey Foundation found 9 that third graders that do not read proficiently are four 10 times more likely to drop out of high school, and low-income students that do not read proficiently are six times more 11 12 likely to drop out of high school; and 13 WHEREAS, Students that cannot read proficiently experience difficulty in every school subject and find it hard to succeed 14 15 academically; and 16 WHEREAS, Students who cannot read proficiently are not 17 well prepared for life after school; and 18 WHEREAS, In the proposed FY24 budget, \$1.5 million has

been dedicated so that every child from birth to five years old

should soon be receiving one free book a month through Dolly

- 3 their children, and the habits that parents model and the
- 4 passions they instill are vital to a child's development;
