WHEREAS, Wetlands, including marshes, swamps, and bogs, play a critical role in reducing flooding, recharging groundwater supplies, and filtering pollutants and nutrients; and

6 WHEREAS, Illinois contains hundreds of ecologically
7 significant wetlands that provide habitat for a rich array of
8 wildlife, including endangered species, and that are critical
9 for migratory waterfowl and shorebirds due to their location
10 within the Mississippi Flyway; and

WHEREAS, Since 1972, the Clean Water Act has played an essential role in protecting aquatic environments from pollution and maintaining their role in providing drinking water, recreation, and wildlife habitats; and

WHEREAS, In 2023, the U.S. Supreme Court dramatically weakened the Clean Water Act in its ruling in the Sackett v.

Environmental Protection Agency case; and

WHEREAS, Sackett concluded that the Clean Water Act does not protect wetlands that do not have a continuous surface connection to a federally protected body of water; and

1 WHEREAS, Illinois has lost 90% of its original wetlands;

- 3 WHEREAS, Illinois has a goal of reducing phosphorus and
- 4 nitrogen levels by 30% by 2035; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Illinois landowners are taking proactive steps to
- 6 protect and install wetlands and buffer habitats; and
- 7 WHEREAS, The State of Illinois has a responsibility to
- 8 protect its remaining wetlands and reduce pollution;
- 9 therefore, be it
- 10 RESOLVED, BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE ONE
- 11 HUNDRED THIRD GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that
- we declare November 8, 2023 as Illinois Wetlands Day in the
- 13 State of Illinois; and be it further
- 14 RESOLVED, That we urge state agencies, local governments,
- 15 and other organizations to work together to preserve and
- 16 protect wetlands.
