1 HOUSE RESOLUTION WHEREAS, Fire fighters serve communities across Illinois 2 3 by putting our safety above their own; and WHEREAS, Fire fighters often work in a toxic environment 4 filled with smoke, soot, and other carcinogens; and 5 6 WHEREAS, According to research, fire fighters have a 9% 7 greater chance of being diagnosed with cancer and a 14% 8 greater chance of dying from cancer than the general 9 population; and WHEREAS, Fire fighter occupational cancer is the leading 10 11 cause of line-of-duty deaths in professional fire fighters and 12 has reached epidemic levels; and 13 WHEREAS, Studies have found a direct correlation between the chemical exposures fire fighters experience on the job and 14 their increased risk for cancer; and 15 16 WHEREAS, All 50 states in the United States recognize 17 cancer as a presumptive workers' compensation claim for fire 18 fighters; and

WHEREAS, Early detection of cancer through routine
