- 17 and urge the Illinois State Board of Education's Student
- 18 Advisory Council to seek public input from Illinoisans at
- 19 every stage; and be it further
- 20 RESOLVED, That we commit to considering the Illinois State
- 21 Board of Education's Student Advisory Council's recommendation
- 22 for a state color and pledge to further collaborate with

- 2 recognition and significance across Illinois; and be it

- 7 state color, including insights gained from student engagement
- 8 activities and any lessons they learned as part of the
