 7 Purnell Shields in Chicago on July 29, 1937; she attended
 8 teaching college; she married Fraser Robinson III in 1960, and
 9 they resided on Chicago's South Side, where they raised two
 10 children, Craig and Michelle, the future First Lady of the
 11 United States; and
- 12 WHEREAS, Marian Robinson worked as a secretary before 13 becoming a stay-at-home mother; she later worked as a bank 14 secretary until retirement; and

WHEREAS, Marian Robinson became a resident of the White 15 House during the eight-year presidency of her son-in-law, 16 Barack Obama, beginning in 2009; during her tenure, she was 17 18 affectionately known as "first grandma", took care of her 19 granddaughters, and successfully avoided the limelight while attending various events, concerts, and state dinners; she 20 21 also joined the first family on a number of overseas trips 22 before returning to Chicago; and

- with her friends and attending weekly yoga classes; and
- 3 WHEREAS, Marian Robinson was a loving mother, a supportive
- 4 mother-in-law, and a devoted grandmother; she will be
- 5 remembered as a grounded, witty, and tough-minded matriarch of
- 6 her family, providing steadiness and a fresh perspective to

- 8 WHEREAS, Marian Robinson was preceded in death by her
- 9 husband; and

- 11 Craig (Kelly) Robinson and Michelle (Barack) Obama, and six
