## HOUSE RESOLUTION

2 WHEREAS, The members of the Illinois House of 3 Representatives wish to congratulate the Illinois Student 4 Assistance Corps (ISACorps) on the occasion of its 15th 5 anniversary; and

6 WHEREAS, ISACorps members are recent college graduates who 7 are trained to help students overcome barriers to education 8 and training beyond high school; and

9 WHEREAS, ISACorps members support students and their 10 families as they explore and navigate postsecondary choices, 11 apply to college, and seek financial aid and other resources; 12 and

13 WHEREAS, The ISACorps provides direct services statewide, 14 ensuring that one-on-one help is in reach no matter where 15 students live or what other resources their school districts 16 are able to provide; and

17 WHEREAS, The majority of ISACorps members have been the 18 first in their families to have completed college and have 19 lived or attended school in the area where they work, and this 20 racially and geographically diverse group includes graduates 21 from across the spectrum of Illinois colleges and universities HR0862 -2- LRB103 41320 LAW 74538 r

1 and various academic paths; and

WHEREAS, ISACorps alumni have advanced to work in policy 2 3 positions, as practitioners, as employees and leaders, and in 4 other important roles in educational institutions, community 5 organizations, research and advocacy groups, and government; 6 as a result, the organization has not only helped high school 7 students directly but has also helped to establish a more representative face on education and public service in 8 9 Illinois: and

10 WHEREAS, The first ISACorps cohort began training 15 years 11 ago in June 2009; since then, its members have served tens of 12 thousands of Illinois students each year through financial aid 13 presentations, FAFSA completion workshops, mentoring, and 14 one-on-one assistance; and

15 WHEREAS, The ISACorps have not only served high school students but have provided interventions at high-need middle 16 schools under a federal GEAR UP grant, supported new college 17 students through the First-Generation Scholars Network, and 18 19 aided older students through community outreach, building and 20 supporting services for regions and individuals that would otherwise have limited access to college access programs and 21 22 support systems; and
