Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Hospital Licensing Act is amended by 5 changing Section 6.26 as follows:

6 (210 ILCS 85/6.26)

Sec. 6.26. Immunization against influenza virus and
pneumococcal disease.

9 (a) Every hospital shall adopt an influenza and 10 pneumococcal immunization policy that includes, but need not 11 be limited to, the following:

12 (1) Procedures for identifying patients age <u>50</u> 65 or 13 older <u>for influenza immunization and 65 or older for</u> 14 <u>pneumococcal immunization</u> and, at the discretion of the 15 facility, other patients at risk.

(2) Procedures for offering immunization against 16 17 influenza virus when available between September 1 and April 1, and against pneumococcal disease upon admission 18 19 discharge, to patients in accordance with the or 20 recommendations of the Advisory Committee on Immunization 21 Practices of the Centers for Disease Control and 22 Prevention that are most recent to the time of vaccination, unless contraindicated. 23

(3) Procedures for ensuring that patients offered
 immunization, or their guardians, receive information
 regarding the risks and benefits of vaccination.

4 The hospital shall provide a copy of its influenza and 5 pneumococcal immunization policy to the Department upon 6 request.

7 (b) A home rule unit may not regulate immunization against influenza virus and pneumococcal disease 8 in a manner inconsistent with the regulation of such immunizations under 9 this Section. This subsection is a limitation under subsection 10 11 (i) of Section 6 of Article VII of the Illinois Constitution on 12 the concurrent exercise by home rule units of powers and 13 functions exercised by the State.
