Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The State Commemorative Dates Act is amended by adding Section 235 as follows:
- 6 (5 ILCS 490/235 new)
- Sec. 235. Tuberous Sclerosis Complex Awareness Day. The

 15th day of May of each year is designated as Tuberous

 Sclerosis Complex Awareness Day to be observed throughout the

 State as a day to bring awareness to this genetic disease that

 impacts 50,000 Americans, to urge those in Illinois to support

 the search for a cure, and to assist those individuals and

 families who deal with this challenging disease on a daily
