Amend Senate Bill 991 by replacing everything after the enacting clause with the following: 3 "Section 5. The School Code is amended by adding Section 4 2-3.196 as follows: 5 6 (105 ILCS 5/2-3.196 new)7 Sec. 2-3.196. Employing manufacturing employees. Subject to appropriation, the State Board of Education shall pay 8 one-half of the salary of an employee that is employed by a 9 10 manufacturing company and working within a school district at a high school as a licensed career and technical education 11 12 teacher. The school board of a school district that intends to hire 13 a manufacturing employee under this Section shall first notify 14 15 any labor organization that has entered into a collective bargaining agreement with the school district of the school 16

board's intent to hire such an employee. If there are eligible 1 employees in the applicable bargaining unit, then the school 2 3 board shall offer to hire an employee who is a member of the 4 applicable bargaining unit. If there are no eligible employees 5 in the applicable bargaining unit, then the labor organization shall notify the school district and affirm that the position 6 is unable to be filled by any members of the applicable 7 bargaining unit.".
