1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 1160

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend Senate Bill 1160 by replacing
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. The Environmental Protection Act is amended by
5 adding Section 22.23e as follows:

6 (415 ILCS 5/22.23e new)

7 Sec. 22.23e. Photovoltaic modules.

8 (a) As used in this Section:

9 "Consumer electronic device" means any device containing
10 an electronic circuit board that is intended for everyday use
11 by individuals.

12 "Photovoltaic module" means the smallest, nondivisible,
13 environmentally protected assembly of photovoltaic cells or
14 other photovoltaic collector technology, and any ancillary
15 part, intended to generate electrical power under sunlight.

16 "Photovoltaic module" does not include a photovoltaic cell

1 that is part of a consumer electronic device for which it
2 provides electricity needed to make the consumer electronic
3 device function. "Photovoltaic module" includes, but is not
4 limited to, interconnections, terminals, and protective
5 devices, such as diodes, that are:

6 (1) installed on, connected to, or integral to
7 buildings;

8 (2) used as components of freestanding, off-grid power
9 generation systems, such as for powering water pumping
10 stations, electric vehicle charging stations, fencing,
11 street and signage lights, and other commercial or
12 agricultural purposes; or

13 (3) part of a system connected to a grid or utility
14 service.

15 (b) Beginning January 1, 2026, no person may knowingly
16 cause or allow the mixing of a photovoltaic module with
17 municipal waste that is intended for disposal at a landfill.

18 (c) Beginning January 1, 2026, no person may knowingly
19 cause or allow the disposal of a photovoltaic module in a
20 sanitary landfill.

21 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect January
22 1, 2025."
