

## 103RD GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2023 and 2024 SB1329

Introduced 2/6/2023, by Sen. Dale Fowler

## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

430 ILCS 66/42 new

Amends the Firearm Concealed Carry Act. Provides that the Illinois State Police shall recognize a concealed carry permit or license issued to a person age 21 years of age or older: (i) by a state whose requirements to obtain a permit or license are substantially similar to the training requirements under the Act or (ii) by any contiguous state with which Illinois has entered into a reciprocal agreement. Provides that a nonresident is subject to the same laws and restrictions as a license holder under the Act. Provides that if a resident of another state who is permitted to carry under this provision establishes legal residence in this State, the license or permit shall be valid in this State for 90 days following the date on which the holder of the license or permit establishes legal residence in this State. Effective immediately.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 2 represented in the General Assembly: 3

- 4 Section 5. The Firearm Concealed Carry Act is amended by 5 adding Section 42 as follows:
- (430 ILCS 66/42 new) 6

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- 7 Sec. 42. Reciprocity.
- (a) Notwithstanding the licensing provisions of this Act, 8 a nonresident may carry a handgun in accordance with this Act if the nonresident:
- (1) is 21 years of age or older; 11
- (2) has in his or her immediate possession a valid 12 license or permit that authorizes him or her to carry a 13 14 concealed firearm issued to him or her by a state whose license or permit is recognized by the Illinois State 15 Police under subsection (b) of this Section; 16
- (3) is not a resident of the State of Illinois; and 17
- 18 (4) is a legal resident of the United States.
- 19 (b) The Illinois State Police shall recognize a permit or 20 license issued by: (i) a state whose requirements to obtain a 21 permit or license are substantially similar to the training 22 requirements in Section 75 of this Act or (ii) by any contiguous state with which Illinois has entered into a 2.3

- 7 who is licensed under this Act.
- 8 (d) If a resident of another state who is the holder of a
- 9 valid license or permit to carry a concealed firearm issued by
- 10 <u>another state recognized by the Illinois State Police under</u>
- 11 subsection (b) establishes legal residence in this State, the
- 12 <u>license or permit shall be valid in this State for 90 days</u>
- following the date on which the holder of the license or permit
- 14 establishes legal residence in this State. For the purposes of
- this subsection (d), the person may establish legal residence
- in this State by:
- 17 <u>(1) registering to vote;</u>
- 18 (2) obtaining an Illinois driver's license or State
- identification card; or
- 20 (3) filing for a homestead tax exemption on property
- in this State.
