Amends the Landlord and Tenant Act. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning covenants exempting a lessor from liability for damages.

1 AN ACT concerning civil law.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Landlord and Tenant Act is amended by changing Section 1 as follows:
- 6 (765 ILCS 705/1) (from Ch. 80, par. 91)
- 7 Sec. 1. Liability exemptions.
- (a) Except as otherwise provided in subsection (b), every 8 9 covenant, agreement, or understanding in or in connection with or collateral to any lease of real property, exempting the the 10 lessor from liability for damages for injuries to person or 11 property caused by or resulting from the negligence of the 12 13 lessor, his or her agents, servants or employees, in the 14 operation or maintenance of the demised premises or the real property containing the demised premises shall be deemed to be 15 16 void as against public policy and wholly unenforceable.
 - (b) Subsection (a) does not apply to a provision in a non-residential lease that exempts the lessor from liability for property damage.
