The Illinois State 2 Police shall charge applicants a fee for conducting the criminal history records check, which shall be deposited into 3 4 the State Police Services Fund and shall not exceed the actual 5 cost of the records check. The Illinois State Police shall 6 furnish, pursuant to positive identification, records of Illinois convictions to the Department. The Department may 7 require applicants to pay a separate fingerprinting fee, 8 9 either to the Department or to a vendor designated or approved 10 by the Department. The Department, in its discretion, may 11 allow an applicant or licensee who does not have reasonable access to a designated vendor to provide his or her 12 13 fingerprints in an alternative manner. Communication between 14 the Department and an interstate compact governing body or 15 other entities may not include information received from the 16 Federal Bureau of Investigation relating to a State and federal criminal history records check. The Department may 17 adopt any rules necessary to implement this Section.". 18
