

103RD GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2023 and 2024 SB1742

SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

10 ILCS 5/29-21 new

Amends the Election Code. Provides that a person commits a Class A misdemeanor if the person, with intent to injure a candidate or influence the result of an election, creates a deep fake video (a video created with the intent to deceive that appears to depict a real person performing an action that did not occur in reality) and causes the deep fake video to be published or distributed within 30 days of an election.

1 AN ACT concerning elections.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Election Code is amended by adding Section 5 29-21 as follows:
- 6 (10 ILCS 5/29-21 new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 29-21. Deep fake videos.</u>
- 8 (a) As used in this Section, "deep fake video" means a
 9 video created, with the intent to deceive, that appears to
- depict a real person performing an action that did not occur in
- 11 <u>reality.</u>
- 12 (b) A person commits a Class A misdemeanor if the person,
- with intent to injure a candidate or influence the result of an
- 14 <u>election:</u>
- 15 <u>(1) creates a deep fake video; and</u>
- 16 (2) causes the deep fake video to be published or
- distributed within 30 days of an election.
