### SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

210 ILCS 9/113 new

Amends the Assisted Living and Shared Housing Act. Requires the Governor to establish an Assisted Living and Shared Housing Advisory Board with specified voting and nonvoting members. Provides that the Advisory Board shall be provided copies of any additions or changes to the Assisted Living and Shared Housing Establishment Code for review and comment prior to notice being given to the public. Contains other provisions.

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning regulation.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**  
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Assisted Living and Shared Housing Act is  
5 amended by adding Section 113 as follows:

6 (210 ILCS 9/113 new)

7 Sec. 113. Assisted Living and Shared Housing Advisory  
8 Board.

9 (a) The Governor shall establish an Assisted Living and  
10 Shared Housing Advisory Board. The Advisory Board shall  
11 consist of the following members:

12 (1) the Director, who shall serve as chair and as an ex  
13 officio, nonvoting member;

14 (2) the Director of Aging, who shall serve as  
15 vice-chair and as an ex officio, nonvoting member;

16 (3) the following nonvoting members, appointed by the  
17 Director:

18 (A) one representative of the Department; and

19 (B) one representative of the Department on Aging;

20 (4) the following voting members, appointed by the  
21 Director:

22 (A) 6 members selected from candidates recommended  
23 by an organization of providers whose membership

1 consists of assisted living establishments;

2 (B) 3 members appointed by the Director from  
3 candidates recommended by a consumer organization that  
4 engages solely in advocacy or legal representation on  
5 behalf of senior citizens;

6 (C) a physician;

7 (D) a registered professional nurse; and

8 (E) 2 members with expertise in the area of  
9 gerontology research or legal research regarding  
10 implementation of laws applying to assisted living  
11 establishments.

12 (b) Members of the Advisory Board shall serve for terms of  
13 3 years or until the member's successor is appointed by the  
14 Director, but the Director shall stagger the terms of initial  
15 appointees to the Advisory Board as follows: the terms of  
16 one-third shall expire after one year; the terms of one-third  
17 shall expire after 2 years; and the terms of one-third shall  
18 expire after 3 years. All initial members shall be appointed  
19 by January 1, 2025. Any member appointed to fill a vacancy  
20 occurring before the expiration of the term for which his or  
21 her predecessor was appointed shall be appointed for the  
22 remainder of that term. The Advisory Board shall meet  
23 quarterly and at the call of the Director. The affirmative  
24 vote of 9 voting members of the Advisory Board shall be  
25 necessary for any action of the Advisory Board. Members of the  
26 Advisory Board shall receive no compensation for their

1 services but shall be reimbursed for their actual expenses.

2 (c) The Advisory Board shall be provided copies of any  
3 additions or changes to the Assisted Living and Shared Housing  
4 Establishment Code for review and comment prior to notice  
5 being given to the public. If the Advisory Board, having been  
6 asked for its review, fails to advise the Department within 90  
7 days, the additions or changes shall be considered acted upon  
8 in accordance with this Section.
