1 AMENDMENT TO SENATE BILL 1834

2 AMENDMENT NO. _____. Amend Senate Bill 1834 by replacing
3 line 3 on page 2 through line 4 on page 3 with the following:

4 "(1) Those who are neglected include any minor under 18
5 years of age or a minor 18 years of age or older for whom the
6 court has made a finding of probable cause to believe that the
7 minor is abused, neglected, or dependent under subsection (1)
8 of Section 2-10 prior to the minor's 18th birthday:

9 (a) ~~any minor under 18 years of age or a minor 18 years~~
10 ~~of age or older for whom the court has made a finding of~~
11 ~~probable cause to believe that the minor is abused,~~
12 ~~neglected, or dependent under subsection (1) of Section~~
13 ~~2-10 prior to the minor's 18th birthday~~ who is not
14 receiving the proper or necessary support, education as
15 required by law, or medical or other remedial care
16 recognized under State law as necessary for a minor's
17 well-being, or other care necessary for his or her
18 well-being, including adequate food, clothing and shelter,

1 or who is abandoned by his or her parent or parents or
2 other person or persons responsible for the minor's
3 welfare, except that a minor shall not be considered
4 neglected for the sole reason that the minor's parent or
5 parents or other person or persons responsible for the
6 minor's welfare have left the minor in the care of an adult
7 relative for any period of time, who the parent or parents
8 or other person responsible for the minor's welfare know
9 is both a mentally capable adult relative and physically
10 capable adult relative, as defined by this Act; or
