Section 5. The School Code is amended by adding Sections
10-20.85 and 34-18.82 as follows:

7 <u>Sec. 10-20.85. Community input on local assessments.</u>

(a) As used in this Section, "district-administered 8 9 assessment" means an assessment that requires all student test takers at any grade level to answer the same questions, or a 10 selection of questions from a common bank of questions, in the 11 12 same manner or substantially the same questions in the same manner. The term does not include an observational assessment 13 14 tool used to satisfy the requirements of Section 2-3.64a-10 of this Code or an assessment developed by district teachers or 15 16 administrators that will be used to measure student progress 17 at an attendance center within the school district.

18 (b) Prior to approving a new contract for any 19 district-administered assessment, a school board must hold a 20 public vote at a regular meeting of the school board, at which 21 the terms of the proposal must be substantially presented and 22 an opportunity for allowing public comments must be provided, 23 subject to applicable notice requirements.
