## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The School Code is amended by adding Section
- 5 17-1.10 as follows:

- Sec. 17-1.10. Operational funds expenditure report and reserve reduction plan.
- 9 (a) In the 2024-2025 school year and in each subsequent
- 10 school year, each school board shall calculate the combined,
- annual average expenditures of its operational funds for the
- 12 previous 3 fiscal years, as reported in the school district's
- 13 <u>most recently audited annual financial reports. Operational</u>
- 14 <u>funds</u> shall include the district's educational,
- transportation, and operations and maintenance funds. The
- school board shall annually present a written report covering
- 17 <u>the annual average expenditures of its operational funds for</u>
- 18 <u>the previous 3 fiscal years at a board meeting.</u>
- 19 (b) If a school district's combined cash reserve balance
- of its operational funds, as most recently reported by the
- 21 <u>district pursuant to Section 17-1.3 of this Code, exceeds 2.5</u>
- 22 <u>times the annual average expenditures of its operational funds</u>
- for the previous 3 fiscal years, the school board shall adopt

- 1 and file with the State Board of Education a written
- 2 operational funds reserve reduction plan to reduce, within 3
- 3 years, the district's combined cash reserve balance of its
- operational funds to an amount at or below 2.5 times the annual 4
- 5 average expenditures of its operational funds for the previous
- 6 3 fiscal years.
