1 AN ACT concerning education.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- 4 Section 5. The School Code is amended by adding Section
- 5 17-1.10 as follows:
- 6 (105 ILCS 5/17-1.10 new)
- Sec. 17-1.10. Operational funds expenditure report and
- 8 <u>reserve reduction plan.</u>
- 9 (a) In the 2024-2025 school year and in each subsequent
- school year, the school board of any school district that does
- 11 not receive federal impact aid funding shall calculate the
- 12 combined, annual average expenditures of its operational funds
- for the previous 3 fiscal years, as reported in the school
- 14 district's most recently audited annual financial reports.
- 15 Operational funds shall include the district's educational,
- 16 transportation, and operations and maintenance funds. The
- 17 school board shall annually present a written report covering
- the annual average expenditures of its operational funds for
- the previous 3 fiscal years at a board meeting.
- 20 (b) With respect to a school district to which subsection
- 21 (a) applies, if the school district's combined cash reserve
- 22 balance of its operational funds, as <u>most recently reported by</u>
- 23 the district pursuant to Section 17-1.3 of this Code, exceeds

- 2.5 times the annual average expenditures of its operational 1 funds for the previous 3 fiscal years, the school board shall 2 3 adopt and file with the State Board of Education by December 31 4 a written operational funds reserve reduction plan to reduce, within 3 years, the district's combined cash reserve balance 5 6 of its operational funds to an amount at or below 2.5 times the 7 annual average expenditures of its operational funds for the previous 3 fiscal years. The State Board shall post any 8 9 operational funds reserve reduction plans received on the 10 State Board's Internet website.
- 11 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect upon 12 becoming law.
