

103RD GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2023 and 2024 SB2302

SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

10 ILCS 5/19-2.5

Amends the Election Code. Provides that an election authority shall notify all qualified voters not more than 90 days nor less than 45 days before a general election (rather than a general or consolidated election) of the option for permanent vote by mail status using specified language. Provides an exception to the requirement to notify all qualified voters for voters who have applied for permanent vote by mail status under specified provisions or voters who submit a written request to be excluded from the permanent vote by mail status.

1 AN ACT concerning elections.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Election Code is amended by changing Section 19-2.5 as follows:
- 6 (10 ILCS 5/19-2.5)

(b) of Section 19-3:

- 7 Sec. 19-2.5. Notice for vote by mail ballot. An election 8 authority shall notify all qualified voters, except voters who 9 have applied for permanent vote by mail status under subsection (b) of Section 19-3 or voters who submit a written 10 request to be excluded from the permanent vote by mail status, 11 not more than 90 days nor less than 45 days before a general or 12 consolidated election, of the option for permanent vote by 13 14 mail status using the following notice and including the application for permanent vote by mail status in subsection 15
- "You may apply to permanently be placed on vote by mail status using the attached application.".
