## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Fair Patient Billing Act is amended by changing Section 35 as follows:
- 6 (210 ILCS 88/35)
- 7 Sec. 35. Collection limitations.
- 8 <u>(a)</u> The hospital shall not pursue legal action for non-payment of a hospital bill against uninsured patients who have clearly demonstrated that they have neither sufficient income nor assets to meet their financial obligations provided
- 12 the patient has complied with Section 45 of this Act.
- 13 (b) A hospital may not bill an uninsured patient that
- 14 requires health care services, as defined in Section 5 of the
- 15 <u>Hospital Uninsured Patient Discount Act, if it determines,</u>
- 16 through its financial assistance screening process, that the
- 17 patient has a household income that qualifies the person for
- 18 <u>free care under the Hospital Uninsured Patient Discount Act.</u>
- 19 If the patient is deemed eligible for public health insurance
- or any other insurance product certified by the Department of
- 21 <u>Insurance</u>, the hospital shall provide information to the
- 22 patient about how the patient can apply for the insurance
- program under subsection (f) of Section 16.
