1 AN ACT concerning appropriations.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

4	ARTICLE 1
5	Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much thereof
6	as may be necessary respectively, are appropriated to the
7	Department of Military Affairs for the purposes hereinafter
8	named:

10	Payable from General Revenue Fund:
11	For Operational Expenses of the

1 Section 10. The sum of \$17,200,000, or so much thereof as 2 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Federal Support Agreement Revolving Fund to the Department of Military Affairs 3 Facilities Division for expenses related to Army National Guard 4 Facilities operations and maintenance as provided for in the 5

Cooperative Funding Agreements, including costs in prior years.

7 Section 15. The sum of \$20,000, or so much thereof as may 8 be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to 9 the Department of Military Affairs Office of the Adjutant 10 General Division for expenses related to the care preservation of historic artifacts. 11

Section 20. The sum of \$1,000,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Military Affairs Trust Fund to the Department of Military Affairs Office of the Adjutant General Division to support youth and other programs, provided such amounts shall not exceed funds to be made available from public or private sources.

Section 25. The sum of \$5,000,000, or so much thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the Illinois Military Family Relief Fund to the Department of Military Affairs Office of the Adjutant General Division for the issuance of grants to persons or families of persons who are members of the Illinois

- 1 National Guard or Illinois residents who are members of the
- 2 armed forces of the United States and who have been called to
- 3 active duty as a result of the September 11, 2001 terrorist
- 4 attacks, including costs in prior years.
- 5 Section 30. The sum of \$400,000, or so much thereof as may
- 6 be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to
- 7 the Department of Military Affairs for deposit into the Federal
- 8 Support Agreement Revolving Fund.
- 9 Section 35. The sum of \$100,000, or so much thereof as may
- 10 be necessary, is appropriated from the State Military Justice
- 11 Fund to the Department of Military Affairs for expenses of
- military justice as provided in the Illinois Code of Military
- 13 Justice.
- 14 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
- 15 2023.
