7 ARTICLE 3

- 8 Section 1. The sum of \$788,500, or so much thereof as may
- 9 be necessary, is appropriated to the Department of Corrections
- 10 from the General Revenue Fund for a grant to the Illinois
- 11 Sentencing Policy Advisory Council.
- 12 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect July 1,
- 13 2023.
