Amend Senate Bill 2586 on page 7, by replacing lines 4 through 11 with the following: 3 4 "(a) As used in this Section, "patient of record" means a patient for whom the patient's most recent Illinois-licensed 5 6 dentist has obtained a relevant medical and dental history and 7 on whom the dentist has (i) performed a physical examination 8 within the last year; (ii) obtained relevant records that are appropriate for the type of teledentistry service being 9 provided from an in-person examination within the previous 12 10 months, including a review of the patient's most recent 11 12 x-rays; or (iii) established a relationship with the patient through an exchange of protected health information for the 13 14 purpose of providing emergency care, treatment, or services in accordance with subsection (c)."; and 15 16 on page 8, by replacing lines 5 through 10 with the following: "other regulatory agency. The Department shall adopt rules to 17

provide for the use of teledentistry in the State of Illinois.

(c) A dentist may treat a patient of record to provide emergent care or conduct an initial consultation using teledentistry for the purpose of treating or assessing for acute pain, infection, injury, or any intraoral or perioral condition that presents immediate harm or discomfort to the patient for which treatment cannot be postponed. A provider of dental services rendering emergent care or conducting an initial consultation through teledentistry must direct the patient to receive appropriate in-person care after the provision of teledentistry services.".
