Introduced 1/10/2024, by Sen. Sally J. Turner - Napoleon Harris, III

SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

30 ILCS 105/5.1012 new 625 ILCS 5/3-699.14

Amends the Illinois Vehicle Code. Allows the issuance of the Illinois USTA/Midwest Tennis Foundation Youth Tennis plate decal by the Illinois USTA/Midwest Tennis Foundation. Creates the Illinois USTA/Midwest Tennis Foundation Youth Tennis Fund. Provides that \$25 of each original issuance and \$38 of each renewal shall be deposited into the Illinois USTA/Midwest Tennis Foundation Youth Tennis Fund, and that \$15 of each original issuance and \$2 of each renewal shall be deposited into the Secretary of State Special License Plate Fund. Provides that money in the Illinois USTA/Midwest Tennis Foundation Youth Tennis Fund shall be paid as grants to the Illinois USTA/Midwest Tennis Foundation Youth Tennis to aid USTA/Midwest districts in the State with exposing youth to the game of tennis. Makes a conforming change in the State Finance Act.

the Secretary, shall accompany each application. Authorized organizations shall be designated by amendment to this Section. When applying for a Universal special license plate the applicant shall inform the Secretary of the name of the authorized organization from which the applicant will obtain a decal to place on the plate. The Secretary shall make a record of that organization and that organization shall remain affiliated with that plate until the plate is surrendered, revoked, or otherwise cancelled. The authorized organization may charge a fee to offset the cost of producing and distributing the decal, but that fee shall be retained by the authorized organization and shall be separate and distinct from any registration fees charged by the Secretary. No decal, sticker, or other material may be affixed to a Universal special license plate other than a decal authorized by the General Assembly in this Section or a registration renewal sticker. The special plates issued under this Section shall be affixed only to passenger vehicles of the first division, including motorcycles and autocycles, or motor vehicles of the second division weighing not more than 8,000 pounds. Plates issued under this Section shall expire according to the multi-year procedure under Section 3-414.1 of this Code.

(b) The design, color, and format of the Universal special license plate shall be wholly within the discretion of the Secretary. Universal special license plates are not required to designate "Land of Lincoln", as prescribed in subsection

- (b) of Section 3-412 of this Code. The design shall allow for the application of a decal to the plate. Organizations authorized by the General Assembly to issue decals for Universal special license plates shall comply with rules adopted by the Secretary governing the requirements for and approval of Universal special license plate decals. The Secretary may, in his or her discretion, allow Universal special license plates to be issued as vanity or personalized plates in accordance with Section 3-405.1 of this Code. The Secretary of State must make a version of the special registration plates authorized under this Section in a form appropriate for motorcycles and autocycles.
- the General Assembly shall set forth whether an additional fee is to be charged for the plate and, if a fee is to be charged, the amount of the fee and how the fee is to be distributed. When necessary, the authorizing language shall create a special fund in the State treasury into which fees may be deposited for an authorized Universal special license plate. Additional fees may only be charged if the fee is to be paid over to a State agency or to a charitable entity that is in compliance with the registration and reporting requirements of the Charitable Trust Act and the Solicitation for Charity Act. Any charitable entity receiving fees for the sale of Universal special license plates shall annually provide the Secretary of State a letter of compliance issued by the Attorney General

- 3 Upon original issuance and for each registration renewal period, in addition to the appropriate registration 5 fee, if applicable, the Secretary shall collect any additional fees, if required, for issuance of Universal special license 6 plates. The fees shall be collected on behalf of the 7 8 organization designated by the applicant when applying for the 9 plate. All fees collected shall be transferred to the State 10 agency on whose behalf the fees were collected, or paid into 11 the special fund designated in the law authorizing the 12 organization to issue decals for Universal special license plates. Public Act.

Section 95. No acceleration or delay. Where this Act makes changes in a statute that is represented in this Act by text that is not yet or no longer in effect (for example, a Section represented by multiple versions), the use of that text does not accelerate or delay the taking effect of (i) the changes made by this Act or (ii) provisions derived from any other
