

## 103RD GENERAL ASSEMBLY State of Illinois 2023 and 2024 SB2751

Introduced 1/16/2024, by Sen. Dan McConchie

## SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

55 ILCS 5/5-12022 new 60 ILCS 1/110-17 new 65 ILCS 5/11-13-28 new

Amends the Counties Code, Township Code, and Illinois Municipal Code. Provides that a veteran with a disability or the veteran's caregiver shall not be charged any building permit fee for improvements to the residence of the veteran with a disability if the improvements are required to accommodate a disability of the veteran. Provides that the applications, forms, and other paperwork required to obtain a building permit must still be submitted. Limits the concurrent exercise of home rule powers. Effective January 1, 2025.

## Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- Section 5. The Counties Code is amended by adding Section 5-12022 as follows:

- 6 improvements to the residence of the veteran with a disability
- 7 if the improvements are required to accommodate a disability
- 8 of the veteran. Nothing in this Section changes the obligation
- 9 of any person to submit to the township applications, forms,
- or other paperwork to obtain a building permit.
- 11 Section 15. The Illinois Municipal Code is amended by
- 12 adding Section 11-13-28 as follows:

- 14 Sec. 11-13-28. Building permit fee for veterans with a
- 15 disability.
- 16 <u>(a) A veteran with a disability or the veteran's caregiver</u>
- 17 shall not be charged any building permit fee for improvements
