Amends the Governor Transition Act. Makes a technical change in a Section concerning the orderly transition of the office of Governor.

A BILL FOR

1 AN ACT concerning State government.

2 **Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,**  
3 **represented in the General Assembly:**

4 Section 5. The Governor Transition Act is amended by  
5 changing Section 1 as follows:

6 (15 ILCS 10/1) (from Ch. 127, par. 63b121)

7 Sec. 1. When at any general election for ~~the~~ the office of  
8 Governor the incumbent Governor is not elected, the Governor,  
9 within 2 weeks after such election, shall provide space for  
10 not more than 5 persons designated by the Governor-elect to  
11 enable the Governor-elect to begin a review and analysis of  
12 budgeted expenditures during the then current biennium and  
13 budget requests for the ensuing biennium and to acquire a  
14 working knowledge of the various offices, departments,  
15 commissions, boards and other agencies of the executive branch  
16 of the State government. The Governor shall cooperate with the  
17 Governor-elect and the staff so designated by him and provide  
18 any assistance that may be reasonably requested.
