"Diagnostic and screening purposes" means for the purpose 10 determining if 11 of individual students need remedial 12 instruction or to determine eligibility for special education, early intervention, bilingual education, dyslexia services, 13 14 advanced academic programs as defined in Section 14A-17 of this Code, or other related educational services. Any 15 16 assessment used to determine eligibility for special education or related services must be consistent with Section 614 of the 17 federal Individuals with Disabilities 18 Education Act. 19 "Diagnostic and screening purposes" includes the identification and evaluation of students with disabilities. 20 "Diagnostic and screening purposes" does not include any 21 assessment in which student scores are used to rate or rank a 22 classroom, program, teacher, school, school district, or 23

(d) Nothing in this Section shall be construed to limit the ability of a classroom teacher or school district to develop, purchase, administer, or score an assessment for an individual classroom, grade level, or group of grade levels in any subject area in prekindergarten through the grade 2.

school or school district for child find under 34 CFR
300.111(c) or evaluation under 34 CFR 300.304.
