SYNOPSIS AS INTRODUCED:

215 ILCS 5/356z.71 new

Amends the Illinois Insurance Code. Provides that a health plan shall limit the total amount that a covered person is required to pay for a covered prescription inhaler at an amount not to exceed \$25 per 30-day supply and shall limit the total amount that a covered person is required to pay for all covered prescription inhalers at an amount not to exceed \$50 in total per 30 days. Provides that coverage for prescription inhalers shall not be subject to any deductible. Provides that nothing in the provisions prevents a health plan from reducing a covered person's cost sharing to an amount less than the cap. Authorizes rulemaking and enforcement by the Department of Insurance. Effective January 1, 2025.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, 3 represented in the General Assembly:

4 Section 5. The Illinois Insurance Code is amended by 5 adding Section 356z.71 as follows:

6 (215 ILCS 5/356z.71 new)

7 <u>Sec. 356z.71. Prescription inhalers.</u>

8 (a) In this Section:

9 <u>"Health plan" means a policy of accident and health</u> 10 <u>insurance or managed care plan that is amended, delivered,</u> 11 <u>issued, or renewed on or after the effective date of this</u> 12 <u>amendatory Act of the 103rd General Assembly that provides</u> 13 <u>coverage for prescription inhalers.</u>

14 "Prescription inhaler" means a prescribed medical device that delivers inhaled medications used to treat respiratory 15 conditions and the prescribed inhaled medication. 16 "Prescription inhaler" includes metered-dose inhalers, 17 nebulizers, and dry powder inhalers. "Prescription inhaler" 18 19 does not include inhalers available over the counter without a prescription to provide temporary relief from respiratory 20 21 symptoms.

22 (b) A health plan shall limit the total amount that a 23 covered person is required to pay for a covered prescription - 2 - LRB103 37942 CES 68074 b

inhaler to an amount not to exceed \$25 per 30-day supply and shall limit the total amount that a covered person is required to pay for all covered prescription inhalers to an amount not to exceed \$50 in total per 30 days. Coverage for prescription inhalers shall not be subject to any deductible.

6 (c) Nothing in this Section prevents a health plan from
7 reducing a covered person's cost sharing to an amount less
8 than the amount specified in subsection (b).

9 <u>(d) The Department may adopt rules necessary to implement</u> 10 <u>and administer this Section and to align with federal</u> 11 <u>requirements. The Department may use any of its enforcement</u> 12 <u>powers to obtain a health plan's compliance with this Section.</u>

13 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect January14 1, 2025.

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
