Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois, represented in the General Assembly:

- (b) It is an unlawful practice within the meaning of this Act for any person providing veteran or military benefits services to:
 - (1) Fail in any advertising to conspicuously disclose veterans services disclosures a veteran's services disclosure when veteran or military benefits services are provided in exchange for any financial compensation, a benefit or thing of value.
 - (2) Fail at the outset of the business relationship to clearly provide, both orally and in writing, veterans services disclosures when veteran or military benefits services are provided in exchange for any financial
