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WHEREAS, The National Multiple Sclerosis Society is committed to a world free of MS and heightening public knowledge about and insight into the disease; and

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WHEREAS, The National Multiple Sclerosis Society has worked to transform what it means to live with MS and has provided global leadership to help achieve a vision of a world free of MS; and

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WHEREAS, Since 1946, the National Multiple Sclerosis Society has been a driving force of MS research by relentlessly pursuing prevention, treatments, and a cure, investing more than \$1 billion in groundbreaking research; and

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WHEREAS, Funds raised through the National Multiple

2 are invested in the MS research workforce at the best medical  
3 centers, universities, and other institutions throughout the  
4 U.S. and abroad, leading to many breakthroughs in the

10 RESOLVED, BY THE SENATE OF THE ONE HUNDRED THIRD GENERAL  
11 ASSEMBLY OF THE STATE OF ILLINOIS, that we declare the month of  
12 March 2023 as MS Awareness Month in the State of Illinois and  
13 recognize the importance of finding the cause and cure of MS;

15 RESOLVED, That we encourage all Illinoisans to learn more  
16 about multiple sclerosis and what they can do to support  
17 individuals with MS and their families; and be it further

21 creating a world free of MS.
