WHEREAS, Donna Haerr was a key figure in establishing the Community Foundation of Central Illinois in 1985, serving as the its first executive director; during her tenure, she helped initiate the Women's Fund in 1993; and

WHEREAS, Donna Haerr was a faithful member of First Federated Church; she served as a lay leader for the church's board and on the Mission Committee to coordinate community reading programs and missions across the globe; and

WHEREAS, Donna Haerr's favorite symphony was Beethoven's Symphony No. 9; in her final years, her artistic muse culminated in a gallery of paintings inspired by her favorite classical symphonies and treasured art pieces from around the world; and

WHEREAS, Donna Haerr was preceded in death by her grandson, Robert Kohn; and

WHEREAS, Donna Haerr is survived by her children, Debra (James) Victor, Mark (Meg) Haerr, Diana (Andy) Kohn, and Eric (Piya) Haerr; her grandchildren, Michael (Taylor Morgan) Kohn, Kathryn Haerr (Matthew) Marcenelle, Christopher (Helena) Haerr, and Davis Haerr; and her great-granddaughter, Gianna Marcenelle; therefore, be it
