2 WHEREAS, In Illinois, the contributions of more than 3,500 3 local Red Cross volunteers give hope to the most vulnerable in 4 their darkest hours; and

5 WHEREAS, The Red Cross provides emergency shelter, food, 6 and comfort for families devastated by local disasters and 7 responds to approximately 2,000 disasters annually throughout 8 Illinois, most of which are home fires; and

WHEREAS, The Red Cross donates blood for accident and burn victims, heart surgery and organ transplant patients, and those receiving treatment for leukemia, cancer, or sickle cell disease and annually collects more than 150,000 units of blood at 5,000 blood drives in Illinois; and

WHEREAS, The Red Cross supports service members and veterans, along with their families and caregivers, through the unique challenges of military life, and local Red Cross volunteers facilitate more than 9,000 emergency services for the military annually; and

WHEREAS, The Red Cross helps to save the lives of others with first aid, CPR, and other skills, and annually, local Red Cross volunteers train approximately 100,000 people in
