- 1 AN ACT concerning schools.
- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Illinois Mathematics and Science Academy
- 5 Law is amended by changing Section 2 as follows:
- 6 (105 ILCS 305/2) (from Ch. 122, par. 1503-2)
- 7 Sec. 2. Establishment, Funding and Location. There is
- 8 hereby created the Illinois Mathematics and Science Academy
- 9 which shall be a residential institution located in the Fox
- 10 River Valley in close proximity to the national science
- 11 laboratories based in Illinois. The Academy shall be a State
- 12 agency, funded by State appropriations, private contributions
- and endowments, tuition charges collected from students, and-
- 14 minimal fees for residential students that also may be
- 15 charged.
- The annual tuition charged to each student of the Academy
- shall be determined in accordance with the following table:

- 24 As used in the above table, "adjusted gross income" means the
- 25 <u>adjusted gross income of the Academy student's family</u>
- 26 properly reportable for federal income tax purposes, as
- 27 <u>determined under the Internal Revenue Code, for the taxable</u>
- 28 year last ending before commencement of the school year for
- 29 which the annual tuition charge is made; and as used in this
- 30 <u>Section</u>, the term "student's family" means: (i) the parents

- 1 of the student; or (ii) if the student has no parent, the
- 2 <u>legal guardian of the student and any spouse of the legal</u>
- 3 guardian who resides in the same household with the legal
- 4 guardian; or (iii) if the student has no parent or legal
- 5 guardian, any relative of the student who is a member of the
- 6 same household as the student and who claims or is the spouse
- 7 of the person who claims the student as a dependent on his or
- 8 her federal income tax return, and any spouse of that
- 9 relative who resides in the same household with that
- 10 relative. The annual tuition charge shall be prorated if a
- 11 <u>student is not an enrolled student of the Academy during any</u>
- 12 part of a semester or quarter of the school term, if the
- 13 Academy actually has divided the school term into separate
- 14 <u>and distinct semesters or quarters.</u>
- 15 The Academy may admit those students who have completed
- 16 the academic equivalent of the 9th grade and may offer a
- 17 program of secondary and postsecondary course work. Admission
- shall be determined by competitive examination.
- 19 In order to be eligible for State appropriations, the
- 20 Academy shall submit to the Board of Higher Education not
- 21 later than the 1st day of October of each year its budget
- 22 proposal for the operation and capital needs of the Academy
- 23 for its next fiscal year.
