Section 5. The Code of Civil Procedure is amended by
changing Section 1-105 as follows:

7 Sec. 1-105. Enforcement of Code Act and rules. The Supreme Court may provide by rule for the orderly and 8 expeditious administration and enforcement of this Code Aet 9 and of the rules, including the striking of pleadings, the 10 11 dismissal of claims, the entry of defaults, the assessment of costs, the assessment against an offending party of the 12 reasonable expenses, including attorney's fees, which any 13 14 violation causes another party to incur, or other action that 15 may be appropriate.
