- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Election Code is amended by adding
- 5 Section 9-8.7 as follows:
- 6 (10 ILCS 5/9-8.7 new)
- 7 <u>Sec. 9-8.7. Prohibited offer or promise. An executive</u>
- 8 <u>branch constitutional officer, an employee of an executive</u>
- 9 <u>branch constitutional officer</u>, or a candidate in a general
- 10 primary election or general election for an executive branch
- 11 <u>constitutional office may not promise anything of value,</u>
- 12 <u>including but not limited to positions in State government,</u>
- 13 promotions, salary increases, or preferential treatment of
- 14 any type, in return for a contribution to a political
- 15 <u>committee</u>, <u>political party</u>, <u>or other entity that has as one</u>
- of its purposes the financial support of a candidate for
- 17 <u>elective office.</u>
- 18 For the purpose of this Section: executive branch
- 19 <u>constitutional officer means the Governor, Lieutenant</u>
- 20 Governor, Secretary of State, Attorney General, State
- 21 <u>Treasurer, and State Comptroller; and employee means a</u>
- 22 <u>full-time or part-time salaried employee or a salaried</u>
- 23 <u>appointee</u> of any office, board, commission, agency,
- 24 <u>department</u>, <u>authority</u>, <u>administrative unit</u>, <u>or corporate</u>
- 25 <u>outgrowth under the jurisdiction of the applicable officer or</u>
- 26 entity.
- 27 <u>Violation of this Section constitutes grounds for</u>
- 28 <u>disciplinary action</u>, <u>including discharge</u>, <u>against the</u>
- 29 <u>offending officer or employee to the extent permissible under</u>
- 30 the Illinois Constitution. In the case of an executive
- 31 <u>branch constitutional officer, violation of this Section may</u>

- constitute grounds for his or her impeachment. 1
- 2 Nothing in this Section prevents the making or accepting
- of voluntary contributions otherwise in accordance with law. 3
