

1                                    AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 1451

2            AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_. Amend House Bill 1451, AS AMENDED,  
3 in Section 20, by replacing the first 2 paragraphs of  
4 subsection (a) with the following:

5            "(a) The Governor shall appoint an advisory committee  
6 to assist in the development and implementation of a  
7 Disabilities Services Implementation Plan that will ensure  
8 compliance by the State of Illinois with the Americans with  
9 Disabilities Act and the decision in *Olmstead v. L.C.*, 119  
10 S.Ct. 2176 (1999). The advisory committee shall be known as  
11 the Illinois Disabilities Services Advisory Committee and  
12 shall be composed of no more than 33 members, including:  
13 persons who have a physical disability, a developmental  
14 disability, or a mental illness; senior citizens;  
15 representatives of statewide organizations that advocate for  
16 persons with physical disabilities; representatives of  
17 statewide organizations that advocate for persons with  
18 developmental disabilities; representatives of statewide  
19 organizations that advocate for persons with mental illness;  
20 representatives of statewide organizations that advocate for  
21 senior citizens; representatives of statewide organizations  
22 that represent providers of services to persons with physical  
23 disabilities, developmental disabilities, and mental illness;  
24 representatives of statewide organizations that represent

1 providers of services to senior citizens; and representatives  
2 of organized labor."
