- 7 Sec. 1. Purpose. The Governor shall designate an agency
- 8 to administer the protection and advocacy system for mentally
- 9 ill persons, pursuant to the federal Protection and Advocacy
- of Mentally Ill Individuals Act of 1986. The agency shall be
- 11 independent of any agency that which provides
- 12 disability-related services (other than advocacy services),
- including treatment, rehabilitation, guardianship, or
- 14 habilitation. The agency may receive and expend funds to
