

1 AN ACT making appropriations.

2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
3 represented in the General Assembly:

4 ARTICLE 1

5 Section 5. The following named amounts, or so much
6 thereof as may be necessary, respectively, for the objects

 19 grants authorized by the Health Services Education Grants
 20 Act.

21 Section 70. The sum of \$1,831,000, or so much thereof as
 22 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
 23 Fund to the Board of Higher Education for distribution as
 24 engineering equipment grants authorized by Section 9.13 of
 25 the Board of Higher Education Act.

26 Section 75. The sum of \$4,700,000, or so much thereof as
 27 may be necessary, is appropriated from the BHE Federal Grants
 28 Fund to the Board of Higher Education for grants from funds
 29 provided under the Eisenhower Professional Development
 30 Program.

1 Section 80. The sum of \$2,750,000, or so much thereof as
2 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
3 Fund to the Department of Public Health for distribution of
4 medical education scholarships authorized by an Act to
5 provide grants for family practice residency programs and
6 medical student scholarships through the Illinois Department
7 of Public Health.

8 Section 85. The sum of \$2,000,000, or so much thereof as
9 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
10 Fund to the Board of Higher Education for distribution as
11 grants authorized by the Illinois Consortium for Educational
12 Opportunity Act.

13 Section 95. The sum of \$10,110,000, or so much thereof
14 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the BHE Federal
15 Grants Fund to the Board of Higher Education to be expended
16 under the terms and conditions associated with the federal
17 contracts and grants moneys received.

18 Section 100. The sum of \$2,100,000, or so much thereof
19 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
20 Fund to the Board of Higher Education for distribution as
21 grants for Cooperative Work Study Programs to institutions of
22 higher education.

23 Section 110. The sum of \$100,000, or so much thereof as
24 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
25 Fund to the Board of Higher Education for graduation
26 incentives grants.

27 Section 115. The sum of \$1,427,000, or so much thereof
28 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
29 Fund to the Board of Higher Education for grants for the

1 Career Academies, including the Public Policy High School,
 2 the Economic and Finance High School, and the International
 3 High School.

4 Section 130. In addition to any amounts previously or
 5 elsewhere appropriated, the sum of \$1,100,000, or so much
 6 thereof as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General
 7 Revenue Fund to the Board of Higher Education for a grant to
 8 the State Geological Survey for ordinary and contingent
 9 expenses, in addition to amounts appropriated elsewhere for
 10 this purpose.

24 Section 5. The sum of \$696,901,100, or so much thereof
 25 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
 26 Fund to the Board of Trustees of the University of Illinois
 27 for any expenditures or purposes authorized by law, including
 28 payment to the University for personal services and related
 29 costs incurred.

1 Section 10. The sum of \$1,000,000, or so much thereof as
2 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Tobacco Settlement
3 Recovery Fund to the Board of Trustees of the University of
4 Illinois for the ordinary and contingent expenses of the
5 Office of Technology Transfer.

6 Section 15. The sum of \$1,408,000, or so much thereof as
7 may be necessary, is appropriated from the Fire Prevention
8 Fund to the Board of Trustees of the University of Illinois
9 for the purpose of maintaining the Illinois Fire Service
10 Institute, paying the Institute's expenses, and providing the
11 facilities and structures incident thereto, including payment
12 to the University for personal services and related costs
13 incurred.

14 Section 20. The sum of \$150,000, or so much thereof as
15 may be necessary, is appropriated from the State College and
16 University Trust Fund to the Board of Trustees of the
17 University of Illinois for scholarship grant awards, in
18 accordance with Public Act 91-0083.

19 Section 25. The sum of \$184,298, or so much thereof as
20 may be necessary and remains unexpended on June 30, 2003,
21 from a reappropriation heretofore made for such purpose in
22 Article 13, Section 30 of Public Act 92-538, is
23 reappropriated from the Capital Development Fund to the Board
24 of Trustees of the University of Illinois to acquire and
25 develop land for expansion of the Chicago campus, including
26 demolition, landscaping and site improvements, planning,
27 construction, remodeling, extension and modification of
28 campus utility systems, and such other expenses as may be
29 necessary to construct a public safety and transportation
30 facility and to develop student recreational areas.

1 Section 30. The sum of \$52,953, or so much thereof as
2 may be necessary and remains unexpended on June 30, 2003,
3 from a reappropriation heretofore made for such purpose in
4 Article 13, Section 35 of Public Act 92-538, is
5 reappropriated from the Capital Development Fund to the Board
6 of Trustees of the University of Illinois to plan for all
7 aspects of construction and to acquire and develop land,
8 including demolition, landscaping, site improvements,
9 extension and modification of campus utility systems,
10 relocation of programs, and such other expenses as may be
11 necessary to construct a College of Medicine building in
12 Chicago.

13 Section 35. The sum of \$40,698,713, or so much thereof
14 as may be necessary and remains unexpended on June 30, 2003,
15 from a reappropriation heretofore made for such purpose in
16 Article 13, Section 45 of Public Act 92-538, is
17 reappropriated from the Capital Development Fund to the Board
18 of Trustees of the University of Illinois to construct an
19 education and research facility for the College of Medicine
20 in Chicago, including planning, land acquisition, demolition,
21 construction, remodeling, landscaping, site improvements,
22 equipment, extension or modification of campus utility
23 systems, relocation of programs, and such expenses as may be
24 necessary to complete the facility.

25 Section 40. The following named amount, or so much
26 thereof as may be necessary and remains unexpended on June
27 30, 2003, respectively, from a reappropriation heretofore
28 made for such purpose in Article 13, Section 50 of Public Act
29 92-538, is reappropriated from the Capital Development Fund
30 to the Board of Trustees of the University of Illinois for
31 the following project:

2 Section 45. The sum of \$12,715,704, or so much thereof
3 as may be necessary and remains unexpended on June 30, 2003,
4 from an appropriation heretofore made for such purpose in

7 University of Illinois for planning, construction, and
8 equipment for a computer science in engineering facility.

9 Section 50. The sum of \$14,873,040, or so much thereof
10 as may be necessary and remains unexpended on June 30, 2003,
11 from an appropriation heretofore made for such purpose in
12 Article 2, Section 106 of Public Act 92-717, is
13 reappropriated from the Capital Development Fund to the
14 University of Illinois at Springfield for constructing a
15 classroom and office building, in addition to funds
16 previously appropriated.

17 Section 55. The sum of \$814,444, or so much thereof as
18 may be necessary and remains unexpended on June 30, 2003,
19 from a reappropriation heretofore made for such purpose in
20 Article 13, Section 65 of Public Act 92-538, is

24 Section 60. The sum of \$477,225, or so much thereof as
25 may be necessary and remains unexpended on June 30, 2003,
26 from a reappropriation heretofore made for such purpose in
27 Article 13, Section 70 of Public Act 92-538, is
28 reappropriated from the Capital Development Fund to the
29 University of Illinois for digitalization infrastructure for
30 WILL-TV (Urbana-Champaign).

1 Section 65. The sum of \$814,444, or so much thereof as
2 may be necessary and remains unexpended on June 30, 2003,
3 from an appropriation heretofore made for such purpose in
4 Article 13, Section 75 of Public Act 92-538, is
5 reappropriated from the Capital Development Fund to the
6 University of Illinois for digitalization infrastructure for
7 WILL-TV (Urbana-Champaign).

8 Section 70. The sum of \$25,000,000, or so much thereof
9 as may be necessary and remains unexpended at the close of
10 business on June 30, 2003, from an appropriation heretofore
11 made in Article 1, Section 16 of Public Act 92-717, is
12 reappropriated from the Capital Development Fund to the Board
13 of Trustees of the University of Illinois to plan and
14 construct an Education and Research facility for the College
15 of Medicine in Chicago, including planning, land acquisition,
16 demolition, construction, remodeling, landscaping, site
17 improvements, equipment, extension or modification of campus
18 utility systems, relocation of programs, and such expenses as
19 may be necessary to complete the facility. This
20 appropriation is in addition to any other funds appropriated
21 for this purpose for this fiscal year.

22 Section 75. The sum of \$15,000,000, or so much thereof
23 as may be necessary and remains unexpended at the close of
24 business on June 30, 2003, from an appropriation heretofore
25 made in Article 1, Section 23 of Public Act 92-717, is
26 reappropriated from the Capital Development Fund to the Board
27 of Trustees of the University of Illinois to plan and
28 construct a Classroom and Office Building at the Springfield
29 Campus and related utility systems, including planning, land
30 acquisition, demolition, construction, remodeling,
31 landscaping, site improvements, equipment, extension or
32 modification of campus utility systems, and such expenses as

1 may be necessary to complete the facility. This
2 appropriation is in addition to any other funds appropriated
3 for this purpose for this fiscal year.

4 Section 80. The sum of \$13,761,948, or so much thereof
5 as may be necessary and remains unexpended at the close of
6 business on June 30, 2003, from an appropriation heretofore
7 made in Article 2, Section 48 of Public Act 92-717, as
8 amended, is reappropriated from the Capital Development Fund
9 to the Board of Trustees of the University of Illinois for
10 all costs associated with the space needs of the Department
11 of Natural Resources, Illinois Natural History Survey
12 Division and State Water Survey Division on the campus of the
13 University of Illinois in Champaign, including construction,
14 capital facilities, planning, relocation, renovation and
15 rehabilitation, mechanical systems, materials, services and
16 all other costs required to complete the work.

18 Section 5. The sum of \$216,703,699, or so much thereof
19 as may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
20 Fund to the Board of Trustees of Southern Illinois University
21 for any expenditures or purposes authorized by law, including
22 payment to the University for personal services and related
23 costs incurred.

24 Section 10. The sum of \$250,000, or so much thereof as
25 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
26 Fund to the Board of Trustees of Southern Illinois University
27 for all costs required to match the Federal Title II Teacher
28 Quality Enhancement State Grant for Southern Illinois
29 University at Carbondale, including payment to the University
30 for personal services and related costs incurred.

2 Section 10. The sum of \$30,000, or so much thereof as
3 may be necessary, is appropriated from the State College and
4 University Trust Fund to Illinois State University for
5 student financial assistance.

6 ARTICLE 8

7 Section 5. The sum of \$56,091,100, or so much thereof as
8 may be necessary, is appropriated from the General Revenue
9 Fund to the Board of Trustees of Western Illinois University
10 for any expenditures or purposes authorized by law, including
11 payment to the University for personal services and related
12 costs incurred.

13 Section 10. The amount of \$10,000, or so much thereof as
14 may be necessary, is appropriated from the State College and
15 University Trust Fund to the Board of Trustees of Western
16 Illinois University for scholarship grant awards from the
17 sale of collegiate license plates.

18 ARTICLE 9

19 Section 5. The following named amount, or so much
20 thereof as may be necessary, for the purpose hereinafter
21 named, is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the
22 Board of Trustees of Eastern Illinois University to meet the
23 ordinary and contingent expenses of the University, including
24 payment or reimbursement to the University for personal
25 services and related costs incurred during the fiscal year
26 ending June 30, 2004 and for salaries accrued but unpaid to
27 academic personnel for personal services rendered during the
