1 AMENDMENT TO HOUSE BILL 2744

2 AMENDMENT NO. \_\_\_\_\_. Amend House Bill 2744 by replacing  
3 everything after the enacting clause with the following:

4 "Section 5. FY05 appropriations based on FY04  
5 appropriations.

6 (a) The items of appropriation (other than  
7 reappropriations) that were appropriated in Public Acts 93-  
8 014, 93-062, 93-064, 93-065, 93-066, 93-067, 93-068, 93-069,  
9 93-070, 93-071, 93-072, 93-073, 93-074, 93-075, 93-076, 93-  
10 090, 93-091, 93-092, 93-093, 93-094, 93-095, 93-096, 93-097,  
11 93-098, 93-115, 93-635, 93-664, and 93-673 for State Fiscal  
12 Year 2004 are hereby appropriated as individual items of  
13 appropriation, and are incorporated by reference, for State  
14 Fiscal Year 2005, to the same agencies, from the same  
15 sources, for the same purposes, and subject to the same  
16 conditions, as those amounts ultimately became law, including  
17 any item reductions and restorations, item vetoes and  
18 overrides, and amendments by subsequent supplemental  
19 appropriation Acts, except Public Act 93-675, also  
20 incorporated by reference.

21 (b) The items that were reappropriated in the Public Acts  
22 listed in subsection (a) for State Fiscal Year 2004 are again  
23 reappropriated as individual items of appropriation, and are  
24 incorporated by reference, for State Fiscal Year 2005, to the

1 same agencies, from the same sources, for the same purposes,  
2 and subject to the same conditions, as those amounts  
3 ultimately became law, including any item reductions and  
4 restorations, item vetoes and overrides, and amendments by  
5 subsequent supplemental appropriation Acts, also incorporated  
6 by reference, but the amounts reappropriated shall be based  
7 on the amounts remaining unexpended at the close of business  
8 on June 30, 2004, rather than June 30, 2003 (or other date  
9 specified in those Public Acts).

10 (c) The items that were appropriated or reappropriated in  
11 Public Act 93-587 for State Fiscal Year 2004 are hereby  
12 reappropriated as individual items of reappropriation, and  
13 are incorporated by reference, for State Fiscal Year 2005, to  
14 the same agencies, from the same sources, for the same  
15 purposes, and subject to the same conditions, as those  
16 amounts ultimately became law, including any item reductions  
17 and restorations, item vetoes and overrides, and amendments  
18 by subsequent supplemental appropriation Acts, also  
19 incorporated by reference, but the amounts reappropriated  
20 shall be based on the amounts remaining unexpended at the  
21 close of business on June 30, 2004 (rather than as stated in  
22 Public Act 93-587, if stated).

23 (d) The appropriations made in subsection (a) and the  
24 reappropriations made in subsections (b) and (c) for State  
25 Fiscal Year 2005 are available for expenditure only (i)  
26 through July 31, 2004 and (ii) except as provided in this  
27 Section, in an amount not to exceed one-twelfth of the amount  
28 appropriated or reappropriated, as the case may be. Any  
29 amount sufficient to pay debt service obligations certified  
30 prior to July 1, 2004 may be expended through July 31, 2004,  
31 and is not subject to the one-twelfth amount limitation. No  
32 further amounts may be expended thereafter.

33 Section 95. Repeal. This Act is repealed at 12:01 a.m. on

1 August 1, 2004.

2 Section 99. Effective date. This Act takes effect on July  
3 1, 2004."
