- 1 AN ACT concerning procurement.
- 2 Be it enacted by the People of the State of Illinois,
- 3 represented in the General Assembly:
- 4 Section 5. The Illinois Procurement Code is amended by
- 5 changing Section 40-25 as follows:
- 6 (30 ILCS 500/40-25)
- 7 Sec. 40-25. Length of leases.
- 8 (a) Maximum term. Leases shall be for a term not to
- 9 exceed 10 years and shall include a termination option in
- 10 favor of the State after 5 years.
- 11 (b) Renewal. Leases may include a renewal option. An
- 12 option to renew may be exercised only (i) when a State
- 13 purchasing officer determines in writing that renewal is in
- 14 the best interest of the State and (ii) upon approval of the
- 15 <u>Procurement Policy Board. The Board's considerations shall</u>
- 16 <u>include</u>, but are not limited to, whether the lease contains
- 17 <u>an option for the State's purchase of property it occupies</u>
- 18 <u>100%.</u> Notice of the exercise of the option <u>must be</u> is
- 19 published in the appropriate volume of the Procurement
- 20 Bulletin at least 60 days prior to the exercise of the
- 21 option.
- 22 (c) Subject to appropriation. All leases shall recite
- 23 that they are subject to termination and cancellation in any
- 24 year for which the General Assembly fails to make an
- 25 appropriation to make payments under the terms of the lease.
